Dear Parent/Carer,

You may be aware that each year we arrange for our Year 6 children to spend an exciting five days at Bryntysillio in Wales.

We have been very lucky again and have managed to secure another visit for 2026! The dates are **Monday 19th to Friday 23rd October 2026** The cost for the week; with full board is **£425.00**. We go earlier in the academic year as we feel that having this experience earlier will be very beneficial to the children. If your child would like to take part in this exciting experience, **please pay your £40.00 deposit on or before Friday 27th February 2026, via your Woodlands Academy of Learning SCOPAY account to secure your child's place.**

I realise that this is a large sum of money and this is the purpose of this letter so that we can begin to collect money from you in plenty of time before the visit. Nearer the time there will be an opportunity for you to meet in school where you will be given all the information, you need about the Centre and what items the pupils will need. Staff leading the visit will have prepared a wide variety of activities to be enjoyed during the week. To help keep the cost to a minimum it has been agreed that the school will cover the transport cost.

To lessen the burden of payment I am proposing that we split the payments across a number of months. The first payment of £40.00 will form a non-returnable deposit and we would ask that this be paid online via your SCOPAY account on or before Friday 27th February 2026, to secure your child's place. This will leave a balance of £385.00. Please see plan below for instalment payment dates. You can also make additional payments as and when you like as long as the balance is cleared by 30/09/2026.
