P.E and Uniform

P.E. will be taught on a **Monday afternoon**. Please wear your school uniform to school and bring a full P.E kit with you to get changed into. Earrings and watches need to be removed. Children **must** remove their own earrings. Please remember that the Woodlands school and PE policy for uniform must be followed at all times.

Home Learning

Home learning will be given out every Friday and should be returned on the following Thursday. Maths, English (grammar or reading) and spellings will be sent out every week.

Mobile Phones and Dismissal

Children can only bring a mobile phone into school if they are walking home. The phone must be switched off on school premises and placed in the box as soon as they enter the school premises. They will be able to collect them from the box at the end of the day when dismissed. Children will only be released to make their own way home without an adult if signed consent is given. Without consent, we are not able to let children leave the premises.

Year 6 will attend a theatre trip towards the end of Autumn 2 (December) and, as an essential part of their Geography learning, a field visit to Wallasey beach during the spring term (May). In addition to these, children will have the option to attend our annual residential to Bryntysilio in October.
