Every 3 and 4 year old is entitled to 15 hours free early year's education per week during term times.

Before starting in a Reception Class, all children are entitled to three terms of part time education in a Nursery School or a Nursery Class in a Primary School.

The table below indicates when children are eligible for a part-time nursery place:

BORN BETWEEN	START DATE
1 April and 31 August	The start of the autumn term following their third birthday (September)
1 September and 31 December	The start of the spring term following their third birthday (January)
1 January and 31 March	The start of the summer term following their third birthday (April)

A place in nursery class does not guarantee a full-time place in the school's Reception class.

To Apply for a Nursery Place

To apply for a nursery place at Woodlands Academy of Learning, you will need to complete the 'Nursery Admission Application Form' and return it to the school office along with the child's Birth Certificate, for confirmation of date of birth and the child's legal name. (We do not need to keep the Birth Certificate, a copy will be taken)

More Applications than Places

If there are more applications than places available, Woodlands will admit children using the following admission criteria (in order of priority)

1. *Children in Public Care (looked after children)*
2. *Pupils who have an older sibling already in attendance at the school at the proposed time of admission*
3. *Pupils for whom a place at the school is essential on medical or social grounds as supported in writing by a medical practitioner or a social worker*
4. *Distance will be measured in a straight line from the centre point of the home address to the centre of the point of the school address using the Local Authority's computerised measuring system, with those living closer to the school receiving the higher priority.*

If there is an over-subscription in Criteria 2 and 3 above, priority will be given to those living closest to the school as measured in a straight line.

PLEASE NOTE: If you are refused a nursery place, there is no right of appeal as nursery education is non-statutory.
