

Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 2 visited Short Heath Methodist Church to learn about the Easter story.

We learnt all about Holy week when Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey. Pupils held palm leaves and shouted 'halleluiah!' They thought about their hopes and dreams and placed a stone with a wish in front of the cross. We then visited the garden of Gethsemane where Jesus was alone. We thought about how it feels when we see someone alone on the playground and how we can help them. Then we learnt about the Passover meal where Jesus had the last supper with his disciples. We ate bread to represent Jesus' body and made a cross sign on our hands with holy water. After that we visited the crucifixion where Jesus died on the cross on Good Friday. We discussed how worried he would have been and said prayers for things we worry about. Finally, we learnt about the resurrection on Easter Sunday and watched as the tomb was opened to discover Jesus had risen again. We were then treated to mini Easter eggs which were yummy!

We had a wonderful time bringing our learning from the classroom to life in a church setting. Our children were praised for their politeness and enthusiasm with the amount of knowledge they have of this Christian celebration.

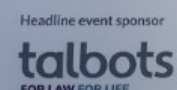

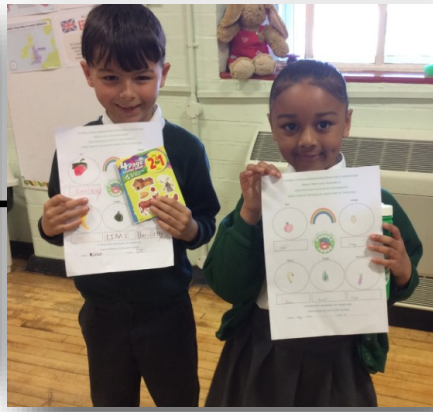

PhunkyFoods Top Tip 4: Don't mistake potatoes!



Although potatoes are a vegetable, they do not count as one of your 5 a day. They are a starchy carbohydrate that provide energy, fibre, B vitamins and potassium.

Sweet potatoes are however one of your 5 a day as they're usually eaten in addition to the starchy part of a meal.

Potatoes are a great addition to a meal as they are so versatile but a portion of vegetables should be eaten too to give that balance.

To obtain all that fibre, leave the skins on where possible to keep in more of the fibre and vitamins.

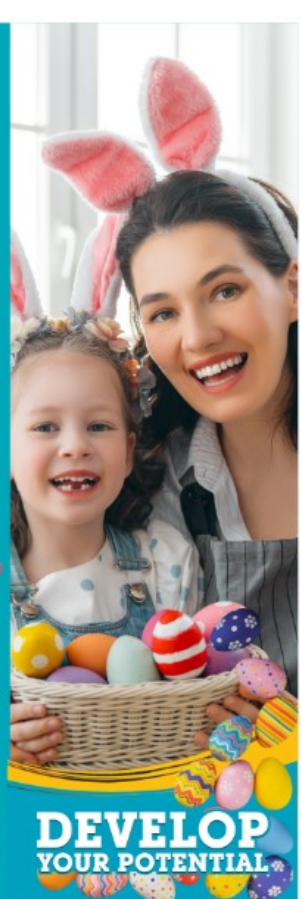
